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APPLICATION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF JEWISH STUDIES STUDY IN ISRAEL AWARDS

Study in Israel Awards offer financial support for both undergraduate and graduate study or research at an accredited Israeli university (Hebrew University, Tel Aviv University, Bar-Ilan University, Ben-Gurion University, University of Haifa, and the Technion) and, in exceptional cases, for students doing independent research in Israel for a thesis or independent study. Consideration will be given only to applicants with documentation of acceptance from an Israeli university. Students will need to comply with all current Rutgers University policies concerning study abroad.

Eligibility and Requirements: To be eligible for a Study in Israel award, the student must be currently enrolled as a full-time undergraduate at Rutgers and must be accepted for undergraduate study at an accredited university in Israel. The student need not be a Jewish Studies major or minor to apply for a Study in Israel Award. Students must submit an application to be considered for these awards, all of which are based on academic merit. In addition to filing this application form, students should submit a copy of their unofficial transcript, provide documentation of their acceptance for study at one of the above universities, and request two letters of recommendation from Rutgers faculty. (Please request these letters from faculty at least two weeks before the deadline.)

A completed application must be submitted to the Department of Jewish Studies at 12 College Avenue by noon on Friday, November 11, 2011.
